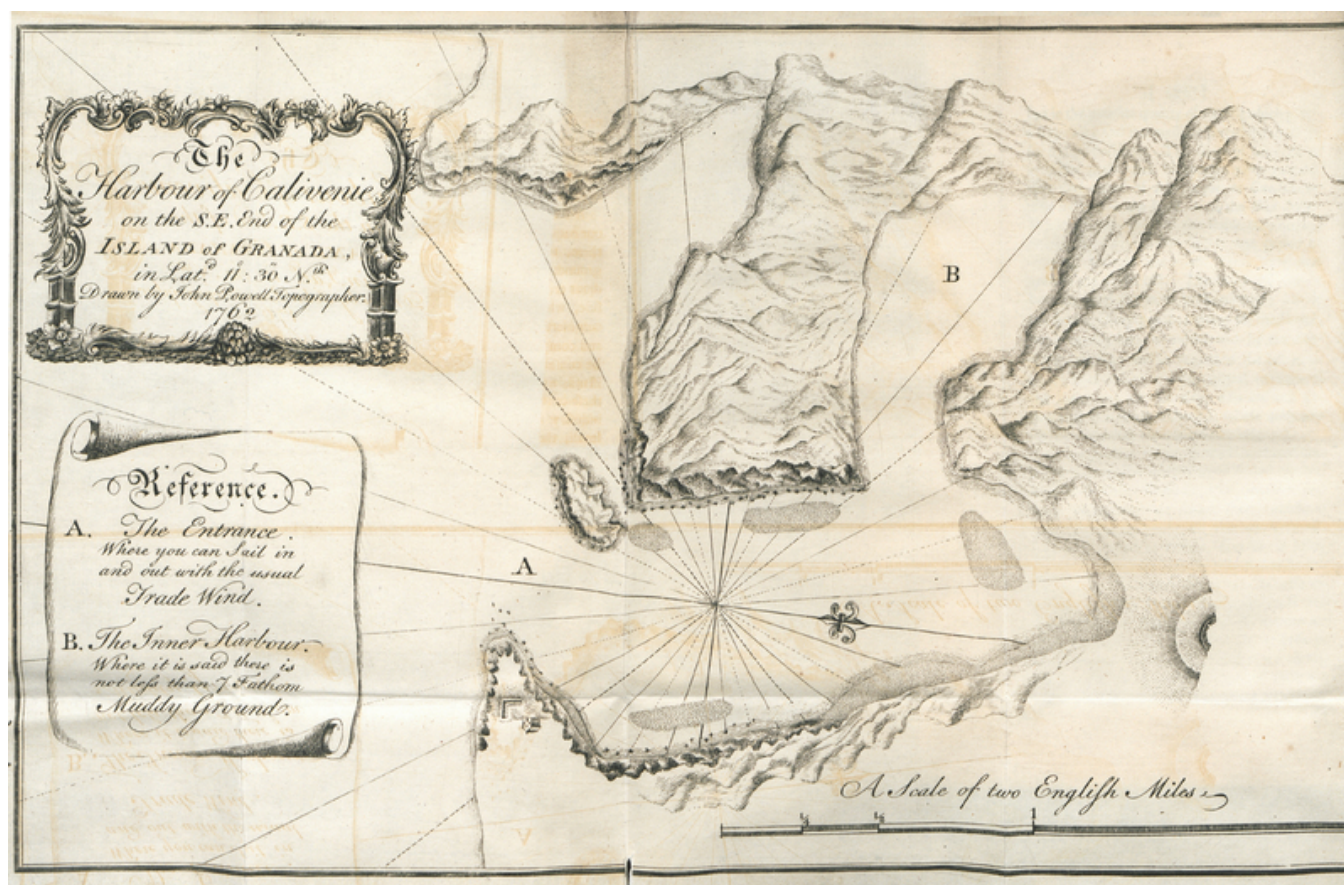




Image
